AVOID ALCOHOL AND DRUG-RELATED CRIMES

Alcohol related crimes can cause visa revocation.

- *No possession or consumption of alcohol under 21*
- *No intoxication while in a vehicle with the keys in your possession.*
- *No verbal or physical assault while intoxicated.*
- *No open alcoholic beverage outside designated areas.*
- *No open container of alcohol in a vehicle.*

Do not use a fake ID – felony carrying prison time and fine.

Marijuana is still illegal at a federal level, even if permitted for medical purposes at the state level.

Do not travel across borders with marijuana or other illegal substances.

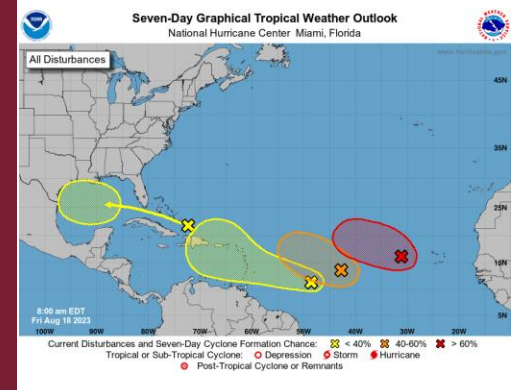
- Victims are not blamed. Report & get help.

HURRICANE SEASON – June to November

- **Download SeminoleSafe (FSU) and Leon County Citizens Connect**
 - Updates about campus closures, finding shelter, etc.
- **Renters' (i.e., tenants') insurance coverage**
 - Is a renters' policy included by your apartment complex? If not, look into purchasing your own before a hurricane is threatening damage.
 - Will the insurance company replace your belongings if needed in case of a hurricane, flooding, fire, theft, etc.?
- **Decide now what method you will use to alert family & friends that you're ok.**
 - A particular social media outlet?
 - Group texts?
 - Group email or email chain?

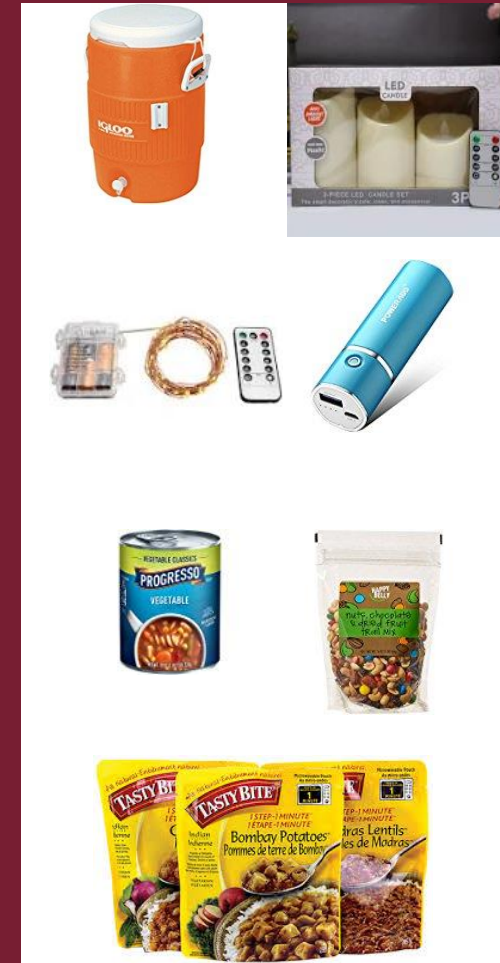




HURRICANE PREP

Prepare now:

- Fill or have available empty water container(s) - no need to buy bottled water
- Place battery-powered lights/flashlights (NOT candles) around your home
- Purchase extra batteries & keep them in a handy place
- Purchase and charge a portable phone charger
- Purchase and store non-perishable food that doesn't require cooking
- Limit the amount of frozen and perishable food you buy and store
- If you have a car, keep the gas tank full
- Monitor weather information regularly -
