Global Exchanges provide a unique and affordable study abroad option at 40+ international partner universities.

Academic credit earned at the host university transfers to the student's FSU transcript and can count toward General Education, Liberal Studies, and Major/ Minor requirements.

Students pay FSU tuition and fees and use their financial aid while studying at the host university. Exchange scholarships are available.

Application Steps

- Attend an info session and review exchange options and course offerings: *global.fsu.edu/exchanges*.
- Work with your academic advisor and the designated faculty advisor to approve your course selection and complete the exchange application: *fsu-horizons.symplicity.com*.
- After the FSU application is approved, complete the host university application and visa process, and attend mandatory pre-departure meetings.

Application Deadlines*

Summer:	March 1
Fall/Academic Year:	March 1
